

Public Utility Commission of Texas
Property Owner Certification Form of Tenant Income Eligibility
For Full Incentive Energy Efficiency Services

This form is to verify that at least 75 percent of the units: (1) are rented by income eligible customers, and (2) have a separate electric meter. The Public Utility Commission of Texas has authorized energy efficiency programs to reduce the utility bills of income eligible tenant households.
